





The playful furniture in Jayson Home & Garden's new Vintage Glam line is a little bit 1970s, and a little more West Palm Beach. "There's definitely a sense of humor to the line," says Devin Kirk, furniture division manager. "It's a little more provocative than what we're known for." The store's buyers scour the country for

pieces with good bones, and then rescue them from outdated finishes and upholstery. A bubblegum-pink canopied bergère chair (1) is transformed with avocado velvet and creamy white wood (\$2,799); a burled walnut tabletop (2) gets dressed up with a splayed-petal base (\$1,350); ottomans (3) are re-covered in unexpectedly
